The Archives Portal Europe Foundation is a network of archives from more than 30 countries that runs the largest online archival repository in the world, <u>www.archivesportaleurope.net</u>, where it is possible to search archival material related to Europe from thousands of different institutions.

We are now looking for volunteers to help us out and gain experience in the various fields of our work from communication, research, and networking to metadata creation and aggregation!

We call this scheme a call for *ambassadors* because you will bring Archives Portal Europe and its activities into your town, working with local communities to connect them internationally.

Or do you have an interest in cultural and creative projects in general? Do you have an interest in digital curation and/or digital communication? Would you like to join an international network and meet people from 30+ countries?

Would you like to gain work experience in an international and multilingual environment?

We are looking for people from any age, background, status, with an interest in cultural heritage, who would like to volunteer in one or more of these types of activities:

- Archival Work & Digital Archives (such as: digitisation projects, ingestion in digital repositories, improving archival descriptions & metadata, working on standards, transliteration of hand-written inventories, topic tagging)
- **History Research** (such as: organisation of digital exhibitions, public history projects, offer help & conduct archival research, collaborate to scientific papers and articles)



- **Digital Curation & Communication** (such as: organisation of seminars and other events, communication on social media and other digital platforms, creation and dissemination of communication material, curation of press releases and PR activities, SEO supervision)
- Language (Translations of website, social media communication, manuals, translating the portal's User Interface, be involved in multilingual projects)
